Ben and the TD2 achieved:

5th overall and Fastest in class at the end of Qualifying

2nd overall and a Win in class in race One

5th overall and a class Win in race Two along with a new lap record for the P4 250cc class at 1m 24.431s

Ben broke his previous lap record by 1 second (set riding the TD2 back in October 2021)

5th overall and a class Win in race Three

4th overall and a class Win in race Four

The overall points that Ben could have achieved (69) would have resulted in 3rd place overall in the 500 Australian Championship. A very good result indeed

The McNamara Park Raceway Historic Period 4 Lightweight 250cc lap record set by Gavin Cosway of 1 m 26.603 s in 2011 has proved to be difficult to equal or lower by many riders; especially, when you consider that there are usually 3 Historic Race meetings per year held at Mac Park. His record has stood the test of time and it is certainly impressive.

Ben is the only rider who has broken Gavin's Lap Record

Up to now 14 times

Ben is the current Lap Record holder 1 m 24.431 s

It's seeming to be a perfect combination of Ben's riding skill coupled with the Yamaha TD2 250 on track performance and reliability.
